


Chart of the Quarter

In the four decades leading up to the 2007–2008 global financial crisis, nearly 26 million new homes were built each decade. In the most recent decade, only 5.8 million new homes were built — the lowest level since the 1930s.



Approximately 20 million less homes have been built over the last decade. This is significantly less compared to previous decades.
